Frequently Asked Questions

1. How can a student apply for membership in the National Honor Society?
Students do not apply for membership in the National Honor Society. Based on the minimum stipulated G.P.A., students must await a request or invitation to complete a National Honor Society application packet.
2. Who selects the students for membership into the National Honor Society?
Membership in the NHS is an honor bestowed upon a student. After eligible students have completed a National Honor Society application packet, selection for membership is by a Faculty Council. The Faculty Council members are appointed by the principal.
3. What characteristics must a student exhibit to be considered for membership in the National Honor Society?
NHS applicants must exhibit outstanding scholarship, character, leadership, and service.
4. What are the responsibilities of a National Honor Society member?
Responsibilities of an NHS member include but are not limited to: attend meetings, participate in service projects, fulfill the required service hours and maintain the standards of the National Honor Society.
5. What is the minimum GPA required for National Honor Society membership eligibility?
Due to the new Cumberland County Schools grading policy, the National Honor Society candidates must have a cumulative weighted scholastic G.P.A. of 4.0.
6. What about student transfers who were NHS members at another school?
A National Honor Society member who transfers from another school and brings a letter from the former principal or chapter sponsor to the new school's chapter sponsor or brings his or her National Honor Society certificate or membership card shall be accepted automatically as a member in the Harold K. Warren Chapter of the National Honor Society. Transfer members must meet the new chapter's standards within one semester in order to retain membership.
7. Are there member dues associated with the National Honor Society?
Yes. Annual dues for the Pine Forest High School chapter of the National Honor Society are \$20.00.
8. When is a student eligible for membership in the National Honor Society?
Membership is open to any sophomore or junior who meets the annually published criteria for scholarship, character, leadership and service.
9. Do National Honor Society seniors automatically get to wear the honor stole at graduation?
Honor stoles are ordered in the spring semester for active members who graduate in good standing. Honor stoles are paid for by each National Honor Society member.
