Davidson College Bryan Scholarship

- Top Senior Athletes (One male and one female)
- Bryan Scholars present outstanding academic records, strong leaders both in the classroom and in their sport and are impact players at the NCAA Division 1 level.
- Deadline dates:
September 21, 2016 - Bryan nomination form, a recommendation form, and transcript.
October 15, 2016 - Submit a completed application for admission and contact Davidson coach of his/her eligible sport via letter or e-mail and provide athletic information.
October 30, 2016 - Finalist will participate in mandatory on-campus interviews.
November 4, 2016 - Winners will be announced.

John M. Belk Scholarship - Davidson College

- A candidate's record and recommendations must demonstrate academic excellence and purposeful engagement in the classroom, in student and civic organizations, on the athletic field, or in the arts.
- School Counselor will nominate 1-2 students
- Complete the form of 1 to 2 nominees, attach transcript, and add a letter of recommendation, **November 7, 2016**.
- Student fills out application **December 1, 2016**.

Morehead-Cain - Chapel Hill

- Must be a competitive applicant to the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill on track to graduate in the spring. 3 Nominated students
- Deadline dates:
September 30, 2016 - Give selected students a copy of the enclosed square card.
October 15, 2016 - Completed applications and recommendations.
December 9, 2016 - Semi-finalist notification.
January 3 -10, 2017 - North Carolina Regional selection interviews.
January 13, 2017 - Finalist notification.
March 4 -7, 2017 - Final selection weekend in Chapel Hill.
March 10, 2017 - Scholarship decision notification.
April 11, 2017 - Deadline to accept the Morehead-Cain.

[Park Scholarship - NC State](#)

- Must apply for the fall baccalaureate program, take the most challenging courses in high school, strong standardized test scores.
- Application for admission to NC State and Park Scholarship on **October 15, 2016**.
300-350 candidates are invited to interview with the Regional Selection Committees. Lastly, candidates interview on NC State's campus in Mid-February. A group discussion activity and an interview with 2 to 4 faculty and alumni. Candidate winners will be notified **March 1, 2017**.

[Levine Scholars Program - UNC Charlotte](#)

- A full scholarship for full tuition, room, board and mandatory fees, housing in honors residents hall, access to a service grant etc..
- Must apply and be accepted to UNC Charlotte, GPA 3.8-4.00 (unweighted) SAT 1900-2400 or ACT 29-36 and demonstrate a commitment to community service and possess a capacity for ethical leadership that will carry students through college and beyond.
- Application, application fee, official transcript and official SAT or ACT (plus writing score).

Deadline dates:

August 25, 2016 - Begin to nominate students.

October 15, 2016 - Nominations are due.

November 1, 2016 - Completed applications.
